PROJECTS

History: Our History project has been 'School Days' where we have been learning about being a child in a Victorian classroom. The children enjoyed the trip to the Victorian Wilderspin School in Barton and were a pleasure to take out. Their behaviour and engagement were exemplary!

Science: The children are looking forward to the end of term trip to Woodside Wildlife Park. This will consolidate learning from the current science project on animals, where they are identifying and labelling parts of animals and then making decisions on their classification.

Art: Our art project has been 'Street View', learning about the American pop artist James Rizzi. His street themed art focuses on brightly coloured smiling skyscrapers.
