At Best Futures we use Read, Write Inc (RWI) as our phonics programme, which helps all children learn to read at speed so they can focus on developing their skills in comprehension, vocabulary and spelling.

We continue to welcome Compass Go into the school weekly to work with our pupils.

What are we learning next half term?

Treetops / Willow classes - Treetops and Willow are exploring the Childhood project, where our pupils will learn vocabulary related to time, study artefacts, and compare childhood past and present. They'll examine life stages, timelines, and family trees, with a focus on the 1950s; covering daily life, transport, shopping, and Queen Elizabeth II's 1953 coronation. Using maps and online sources, they'll identify changes over time and create knowledge organisers to support future learning. They will also be enjoying a visit to Time Trap in Grimsby next half term, where they will see for themselves what people used before we had all of the technology of today.

Oak class - This term, the children have been exploring British prehistory, from the Stone Age through to the Iron Age. Through this topic, they are learning how people's lives changed over time due to new inventions, discoveries, and technological progress. In English, pupils are using this historical context to inspire their narrative writing. They are developing their skills in describing settings, characters, and plot, and are beginning to use direct speech to bring their stories to life and move the action forward. These imaginative stories may include fictional elements but are grounded in the historical periods they've been learning about. They will be visiting The Prehistory Hull museums and galleries in December to consolidate their learning.

The children continue to work hard across Maths and English as well as enrichment and other areas of the curriculum. They are developing and enhancing many skills!
